

Santa Cruz City Schools has contracted with DecisionInsite, a demographer, to project enrollment for the next decade. The following report takes into consideration: current enrollment data; feeder district enrollment data; birth rates; open enrollment and interdistrict transfers data; as well as local housing development planning. 2015-16 enrollment in district schools has declined 134 students from 2014-15. Since the year 2000, Santa Cruz City Schools enrollment has declined by 1,514 students and the projections continue this downward movement.
