- Re-iteration here that we are proceeding with option 1 (refer 7/28/21 meeting minutes)
- Existing electrical switchgear is not adequate to serve new building and existing campus.
- Current plan of action as directed previously is setting back building from street and leaving existing transformer in place.
- Brian reviewed the fact that aesthetic improvement cost proposals have been requested from AMS.
- Plan of action is: Set back building. Leave transformer, Bid alternate with fence/wall/courtyard as a bid-alternate
- Removal of trees and repair of street sidewalk will be done separately from this project.
- Brian noted that "PCO" costs have been presented. Painting costs have been reduced significantly.
- Amariah asked will building be in front. Brian shared image of plan. Amariah noted that she primarily wants to be aware of it so that she can carefully explain it to stakeholders.

#### Minutes from 07/28/21 for Continuity

- Reviewed building placement. Options 1 Keep transformer in place (moves building away from street). 2 Add an outdoor enclosed area to take advantage of outdoors space. 3 Move transformer. In this review, we reviewed cost options provided by AMS, and Cost Estimates for building locations developed by BA.
- BA estimates cost of Transformer/Switchgear to be in the range of \$1M, CG estimates the Transformer/Switchgear to be in the range of \$400-\$450K.
- Per review by all attendees of both AMS aesthetic improvement costs ("Optional Exterior Features") the following direction was provided by CG/AH regarding new building:
  - o Locate the new classroom building behind the existing transformer.
